



2010 PUBLIC INTEREST SCHOLARSHIP

Since 1991, the Foundation has awarded nearly \$2.9 million through its scholarship programs. Investing in the next generation of public interest lawyers, the flagship Public Interest Scholarship has benefited more than 550 outstanding law students. The Scholarship helps pay the costs of obtaining a law school education, including tuition, fees, books, and related education expenses. Awards of up to \$7,500 recognize law students who demonstrate superior academic achievement, a sustained and extensive commitment to public service, often while overcoming serious personal hardships and obstacles, an intent to pursue a career in public interest law, and financial need.

The top awards of \$7,500 may be made in the name of a Public Interest Scholarship Fund donor. All 2010 Public Interest Scholarships will be awarded in person at a reception to be held on Thursday, September 30, 2010, in Los Angeles.

CRITERIA, INSTRUCTIONS & CONDITIONS

The Public Interest Scholarship is awarded in the fall of 2010 for the 2010-2011 academic year. The 2010 Application Deadline is **4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 17, 2010.**

CRITERIA

1. Candidate must be enrolled in a California law school:
 - At the time of submitting a Public Interest Scholarship Application (Spring 2010); and
 - In the academic year for which the Public Interest Scholarship is awarded (2010-2011).
2. Candidate must have completed at least one year of study at a California law school by the time Public Interest Scholarships are distributed in September 2010.
3. Candidate must demonstrate and document a strong commitment to public service, as supported by a minimum of three current letters of recommendation, and intend to pursue a public interest legal career after law school.
4. Candidate must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA or equivalent on a 4.0 scale (or provide an explanation of extenuating circumstances if GPA is lower) and provide the grading curve used at Candidate's law school.
5. Candidate's law school must certify:
 - Good ethical standing of Candidate while attending law school; and
 - Candidate's financial need.
6. Candidate must be chosen as one of a maximum of **five** Candidates nominated by his/her law school.
7. Candidates from online law schools must be California residents.
8. Any prior Foundation scholarship awards received by Candidate will be taken into consideration.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. All portions of the Application must be **received** by the Foundation by **4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 17, 2010** (the "Application Deadline"). Attachments, letters of recommendation, and law school documents may be submitted separately, though **Candidates are strongly encouraged to submit one packet with all application materials**. Please note that in order to provide enough time to select its nominees, a law school typically requires that Candidates submit their Applications to the law school on a date earlier than the Foundation's Application Deadline.

3. Applications postmarked by the Application Deadline but not received in full by the Application Deadline will not be accepted.
4. All documents submitted in association with Candidate's Application for the Public Interest Scholarship should include the name of Candidate on each page, including law school documents and letters of recommendation.
5. Applications submitted via email should be sent as a single PDF document.
6. See the Application Checklist for a complete list of documentation that must be submitted.

CONDITIONS

1. Public Interest Scholarship Recipients must:
 - Attend a reception in their honor, which is currently scheduled for Thursday, September 30, 2010, at 5:00 pm in Los Angeles. The Foundation will provide stipends to help cover the travel costs of attending this event for Recipients who do not attend law school in the Los Angeles area. *Failure to attend may result in forfeiture of Recipient's Public Interest Scholarship, without notice.*
 - Provide the Foundation, in a timely fashion, contact information for every date between the Application Deadline and the date of the Scholarship Reception. *Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of Recipient's Public Interest Scholarship, without notice.*
 - Arrange to have the Foundation receive an end-of-the-year transcript for the 2009-2010 academic year by August 1. *Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of Recipient's Public Interest Scholarship, without notice.*
 - Report back to the Foundation on their legal careers following their law school graduation.
2. Public Interest Scholarship Recipients will be requested to provide a recent digital photograph of themselves upon receiving notification of their award. *Please do not send photos with Application.*
3. The Foundation reserves the right to use information from Applications and letters of recommendation as part of its publicity of Public Interest Scholarship Recipients.
4. Public Interest Scholarship Recipients are expected to pursue public interest legal careers after law school.
5. Public Interest Scholarship Award Recipients receiving named scholarships may be asked to contact donors supporting their scholarships and invited to attend firm events.

- ✓ **Letters of Recommendation** – Three current letters of recommendation supporting Candidate's commitment to public service.
- ✓ **Law School Transcript** – Copy of Candidate's transcript with the most recent GPA (including explanation of 2.5 equivalency for those law schools that do not use a 4.0 scale), including a description of Candidate's law school's grading curve. Please also include a detailed explanation of any extenuating circumstances if Candidate's GPA is lower than 2.5 or equivalent.
- ✓ **Certification of Financial Need** – Certification from law school financial aid office of Candidate's financial need (either by completing the form enclosed with this application or by submitting the form prepared by the financial aid office setting forth Candidate's financial aid package as well as total amount of outstanding undergraduate, law school, and other graduate program loans, by category).
- ✓ **Certification of Ethical Standing and Statement of Nomination** – Letter from law school (1) verifying Candidate's enrollment and good ethical conduct during the academic year in which Candidate's Application is filed, and (2) certifying that Candidate is one of the law school's five nominees.
- ✓ **Optional Statement of Financial Circumstances** – Candidate may choose to submit an additional, optional statement of up to 50 words describing any financial circumstances that Candidate believes may be relevant in determining Candidate's financial need (for example, if Candidate worked to pay for most or all undergraduate costs).
