



2010 ROSENTHAL BAR EXAM SCHOLARSHIP

The Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship Program recognizes outstanding graduating California law students with financial need who are embarking on careers in public service law by providing financial support for costs related to taking the California Bar Exam. Winners will receive California Bar/Bri Law Review Bar Exam review courses and/or \$2,000 in cash to help defray fees and related expenses of taking the California Bar Exam.

Through this Program, the Foundation is committed to supporting law students pursuing a career in public interest law by providing critical financial assistance to help students cover expenses between graduating from law school and passing the bar exam. As one of the only scholarship programs in the country that helps public interest law students pay bar exam expenses, the Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship supports the pipeline of young California lawyers entering the legal profession as public interest attorneys.

The Scholarship is named in honor of Imelda Rosenthal, an émigré from Guatemala. Upon her arrival to the U.S., she learned the language and customs and soon was running a successful company. Reflecting upon her early days in America, Imelda began using a portion of her business' profits to help other young immigrants. After passing away from cancer-related illness, her family established a memorial fund, which led to the creation of the Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship Program. The Program is made possible by the generous support of law firms, voluntary donations from members of the California Bar, including prior scholarship recipients, and the Rosenthal family.

CRITERIA, INSTRUCTIONS & CONDITIONS

The Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship is awarded in the Spring of 2010. The 2010 Application Deadline is **4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 10, 2010.**

CRITERIA

1. Candidate must be:
 - Graduating or have graduated from a California law school in the 2009-2010 academic year; and
 - Taking the California Bar Exam in 2010 for the first time.
2. Candidate must demonstrate and document a strong commitment to public service, as supported by a minimum of one current letter of recommendation, and intend to pursue a public interest legal career after law school.
3. Candidate must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA or equivalent on a 4.0 scale (or provide an explanation of extenuating circumstances if GPA is lower than 2.5).
4. Candidate's law school must certify:
 - Candidate's actual or anticipated graduation date;
 - Good ethical standing of Candidate while attending law school; and
 - Candidate's financial need.
5. Candidate must have filed his/her application for Moral Character Determination with the State Bar of California by the Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship Application Deadline.
6. Candidate must be chosen as one of a maximum of **four** Candidates nominated by his/her law school.
7. Candidates from online law schools must be California residents.
8. Any prior Foundation scholarship awards received by Candidate will be taken into consideration.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. All portions of the Application must be received by the Foundation by **4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 10, 2010** (the "Application Deadline"). Attachments, letter(s) of recommendation, and law school documents may be submitted separately, but must also be received by the Application Deadline. Please note that in order to provide enough time to select its nominees, a law school typically requires that Candidates submit their Applications to the law school on a date earlier than the Foundation's Application Deadline.

3. Applications postmarked by the Application Deadline but not received in full by the Application Deadline will not be accepted.
4. All documents submitted in association with Candidate's Application for the Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship, including letter(s) of recommendation, should include the name of Candidate on the upper right-hand corner of each page.
5. See the Application Checklist for a complete list of required documentation that must be submitted.

CONDITIONS

1. Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship Recipients will be requested to provide a recent digital photograph of themselves upon receiving notification of their award. *Please do not send photos with Application.*
2. The Foundation requires Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship Recipients to report back to the Foundation on the progress of their public interest careers during the next year.
3. The Foundation reserves the right to use information from Applications and letters of recommendation as part of its publicity of Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship Recipients.
4. Rosenthal Bar Exam Scholarship Recipients receiving named scholarships may be asked to contact donors supporting their scholarships.

- ✓ **Resume** – Designate your volunteer service since high school with double asterisks (**). Include all legal employment while in law school.
- ✓ **Personal Statement** – One-page statement, not to exceed 400 words, describing your commitment to and plans for a legal career in public service.
- ✓ **Letter of Recommendation** – One current letter of recommendation supporting your commitment to public service.
- ✓ **Law School Transcript** – Copy of your transcript with your most recent GPA (including explanation of 2.5 equivalency for those law schools that do not use a 4.0 scale) and a description of your law school's grading curve. Please also include a detailed explanation of any extenuating circumstances if your GPA is lower than 2.5. This can be an unofficial transcript, but it must clearly identify the applicant and the school by name.
- ✓ **Certification of Financial Need** – Certification from your law school financial aid office of your financial need (either by completing the form enclosed with this application or by submitting the form prepared by your financial aid office setting forth your financial aid package as well as total amount of outstanding undergraduate, law school, and other graduate program loans, by category).
- ✓ **Certification of Ethical Standing and Statement of Nomination** – Letter from your law school (1) verifying your enrollment and good ethical conduct during the academic year in which your Application is filed, (2) stating your known or anticipated graduation date, and (3) certifying that you are one of your law school's **four** nominees.
- ✓ **Optional Statement of Financial Circumstances** – Candidate may choose to submit an additional, optional statement of up to 50 words describing any financial circumstances that Candidate believes may be relevant in determining Candidate's financial need (for example, if Candidate worked to pay for most or all undergraduate costs).

Note: Candidate's name must appear in the upper right-hand corner of each page of every document submitted with the application, including letter(s) of recommendation.
